

Practical Information

Conference Venue

The conference will be held on the campus of the Ruprecht-Karls-Universität Heidelberg in the north-west of Heidelberg. All street addresses on the campus are Im Neuenheimer Feld, INF for short, and usually building INF xyz has the number xyz written on it.

Registration, plenary talks, tutorials, some special session talks, and the conference bureau are in the **Physics Lecture Theatre INF 308**, a not so high blue building adjacent to a small pond. Parallel sessions take place in the **Mathematical Institute INF 288** on the other side of the pond.

To reach the conference site by bus or tram, go to the stop Bunsengymnasium, which is highlighted on the map. Then walk perpendicular to the tram tracks and towards the campus, passing parking lots first on both sides and then to the left only. About 200 meters away from the tram station, you reach the large central square of the campus with a pavement that shows the solar system as concentric circles. A few meters off the square to your right you see the Physics Lecture Theatre INF 308 and the Mathematical Institute INF 288.

Registration and Conference Bureau

The conference bureau is located in the lobby of the Physics Lecture Theatre INF 308, the building where the plenary talks take place. Here registered participants will collect their conference materials and name tags. Walk-in registration will also be possible during the first days of the conference. Please note that all payments have to be made by cash (in Euro). If you have any problems or need help, you may always ask the members of the organizing committee, identifiable by their green name tags, or contact us at the conference bureau during the following opening hours.

WiFi Access

Free WiFi is available during the conference in the Physics Lecture Theatre (INF 308) where the plenary talks and tutorials take place. Logging on is done by simply searching for a wireless network and selecting the open unencrypted network "Universität Heidelberg". (The same network can be found in all other buildings, but it will be encrypted and therefore inaccessible.)

Your computer's wireless connection needs to be in default configuration, that is it must be set to automatically pick up an IP address and a DNS server (DHCP).

Computing Lab

A small computing lab with access to the Internet will be open for conference participants' use during the conference period. It is located in the basement of the Mathematical Institute, building INF 288, where the Contributed Talks and most of the Special Sessions will be given. After entering the building just go down the staircase halfway on your left and follow the information signs to get there. The computing lab will be open between 10 am and 2.30 pm from Monday to Friday.

Smoking

Please notice that there is a strict non-smoking policy on the campus. Smoking is not allowed anywhere inside the buildings of the conference venue (similar to German restaurants).

Eating around Campus

Zentralmensa Neuenheimer Feld (Student Canteen)

Opening hours: 11.30 am - 2.00 pm (Mon-Fri)

The Mensa does not accept cash and as a guest you can only eat there after having obtained Mensa vouchers from the conference bureau. If you haven't booked them in advance, you can still buy a set of five vouchers at the conference bureau on a first-come-first-serve basis, subject to availability. A set is €40,00. We cannot sell single vouchers, but each voucher can be used on every day and is transferrable if you want to share them. One mensa voucher is valid for a full meal, including one helping from the buffet plus soup, dessert and a drink. CiE participants will only be served at counter B. To get there, after entering the building from the main (north) entrance, follow the ramp in front of you and then take the staircase just ahead of you.

Café Botanik (Student Cafeteria)

Opening hours: 8 am - 11 pm (Mon-Fri)

This is a self-service restaurant and beer garden in the same building as the Zentralmensa. While the local students can pay with their "campus card", for guests it is possible to pay in cash (although then the prices are slightly higher). Eating here is a good option if you are looking for reasonably priced quick food. Afterwards you may want to take a stroll through the botanical gardens right behind the café.

Casino DKFZ

Opening hours: 11 am - 4.30 pm, lunch 11 am - 2.30 pm

The self-service cafeteria "Casino" of the German Cancer Research Center (DKFZ) is directly opposite the Bellini. Just enter through the revolving door and in the lobby turn left to get to the cafeteria. Only the cashier on the right accepts cash. There is no food offered after 2.30 pm, but it is still possible to have a coffee here.

Situated directly on the campus, this restaurant offers various pasta dishes, American food, and a range of Alsatian "Flammkuchen" (Tarte Flambee, special price on Monday). When the weather is nice, it is possible to sit at tables on the outside. For longdrink lovers, there are also special happy hours from 5-7 pm and from 9-11 pm. Only a few metres from here is the "Café Bellini - coffee and more" with its sun terrace, serving reasonable Italian food.

Mamma Leone

Mamma Leone, situated in about 5 minutes walking distance from the conference site, is a traditional Italian restaurant, serving a variety of pizzas and pastas.

Olive Restaurant Méditerranée

A restaurant in about 10-15 minutes walking distance from the campus, roughly beneath the tall chimney north of the campus. The terrace of the Olive is nicely situated, overlooking tennis courts and an agricultural area with fields and small gardens. The food is tasty and includes mediterranean-style dishes and German cuisine.

Conference Dinner

The conference dinner will take place in Restaurant Romer, the restaurant of the Arthotel Heidelberg, on Wednesday. Please bring your voucher for the dinner which you should have received with your registration if you booked one. If you still want to buy a voucher, we have a few left which are sold at the conference bureau for €50 per person (subject to availability, so you should come as early as possible). There will be a reception on the roof garden of the hotel at 7.30 p.m., the dinner will start around 8 p.m. Please enter through the gate right of the restaurant.

The Arthotel is about 80 m uphill from University Square, at the corner Grabengasse and Seminarstraße, facing the church Peterskirche. The next bus stops are Universitätsplatz or Peterskirche, both served by bus 31.

How to Reach the Campus

The stop Bunsengymnasium can be reached by public transportation from Heidelberg main station by Tram 21 or 24, from Bismarckplatz by Bus 31 or Tram 21, from University Square in Old Town by Bus 31.

Make sure to go in the right direction, for Bus 31 go in direction "Neuenheim Chirurgische Klinik", for Tram 21 go in direction "Handschuhsheim Bahnhof OEG", for Tram 24 go in direction "Handschuhsheim Burgstrasse".

Note that due to construction work there may be several changes concerning buses serving the campus and the youth hostel. However, this should not affect the connections described above.



Tickets for Buses and Trams

Tickets can be bought at a counter in the main station, from vending machines at stations and from bus drivers. Note that there are no tickets sold in trams, i.e., you have to get them in advance. Depending on where you buy them, they may come with a time stamp, if not, the ticket must be punched when getting on the bus or tram.

There is a unified public transportation system for a wide area around Heidelberg. The following prices are for rides within Heidelberg centre and adjacent suburbs. A single ticket is 2.10 Euro, 5 tickets are 9.30 Euro. There is a 24-hour ticket available (which is valid till Monday 3 a.m. when bought on the weekend). The price is 5.20 Euro for one person (Ticket 24) and 9.00 Euro for a group of up to 5 persons (Ticket 24 Plus).

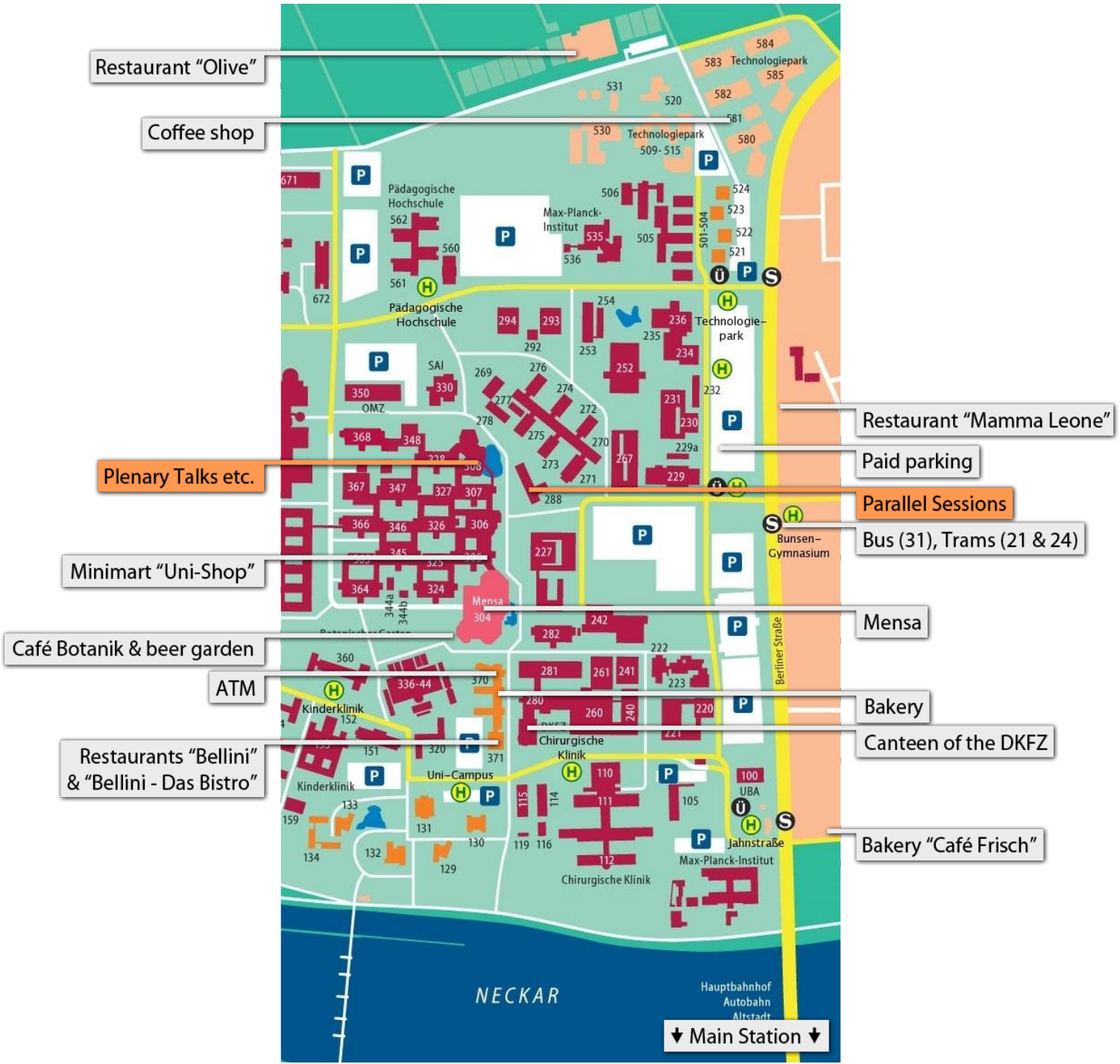
